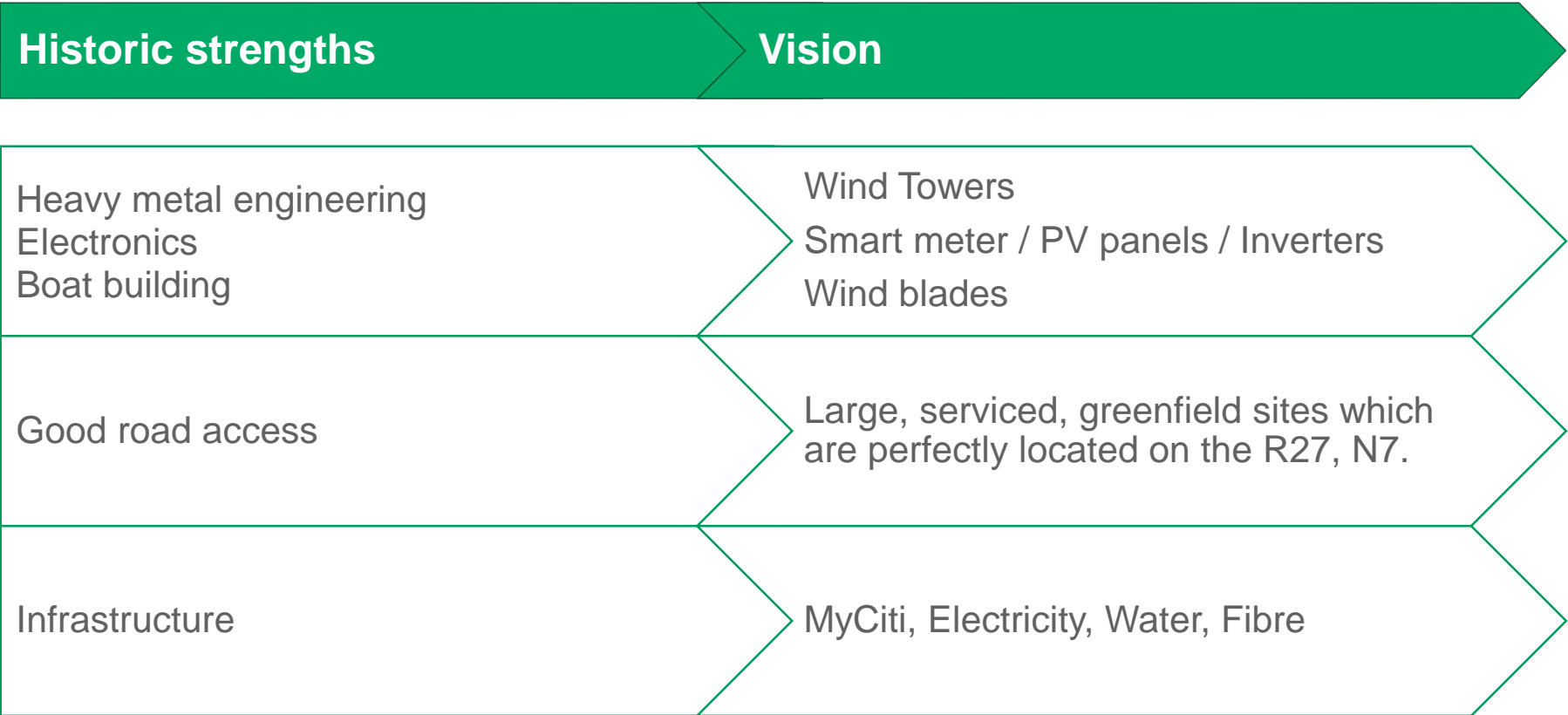
Mission statement
