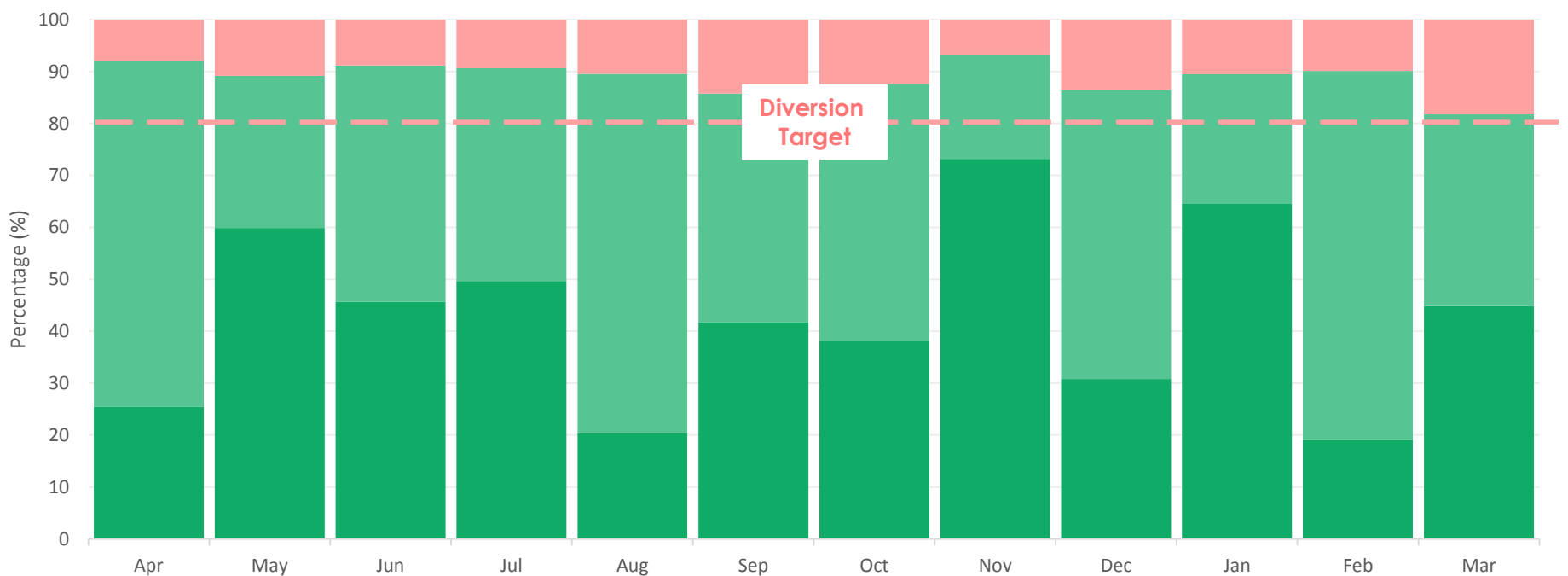
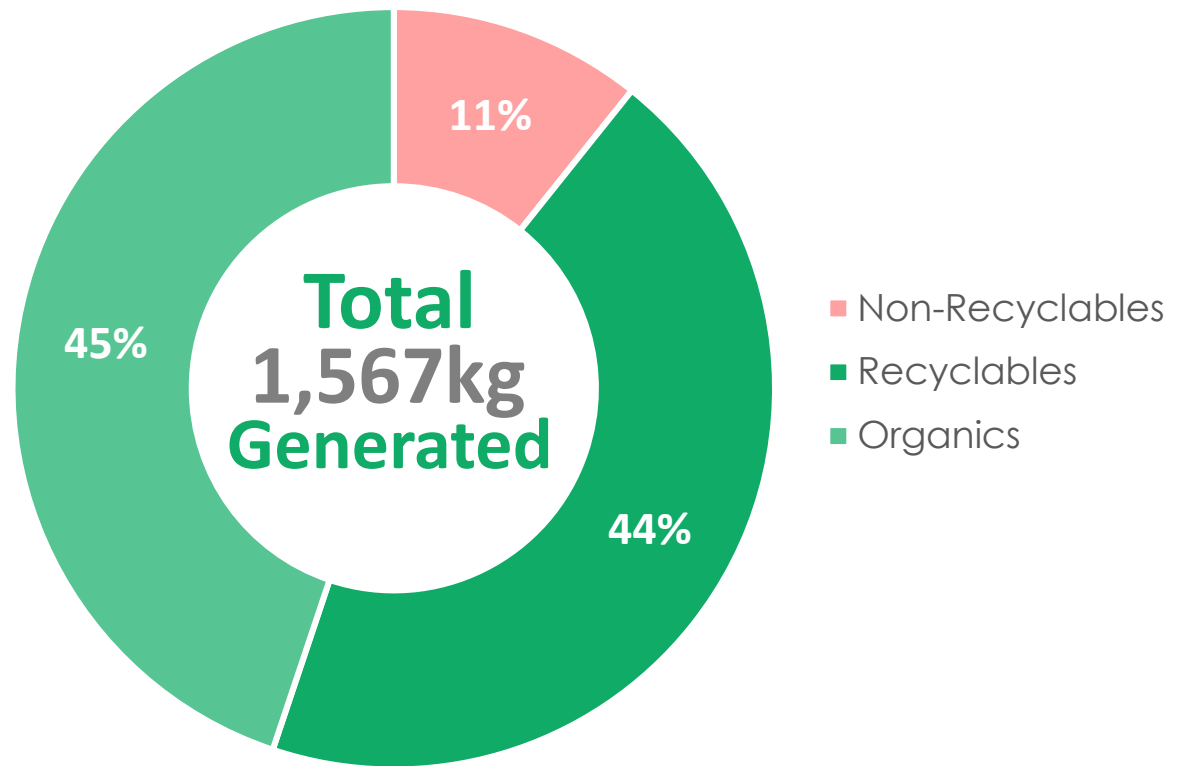


Waste@Work

2017/2018



GreenCape consistently meets the 80% diversion target set in February 2015. Of the 1.5 tonnes of waste we have generated over the course of the 2017/18 financial year, 703kg (45%) has been diverted to Oranjezicht City Farm for composting. This would result in ±70kg of compost used to grow vegetables for the OZCF market and broader community. GreenCape has also shifted an estimated 696kg (44%) of dry recyclables to Oasis Recycling to be separated into valuable secondary materials. Money generated from the sale of these materials was subsequently used to support the NPO. Oasis plays an ever important role in providing purpose to the intellectually challenged, and most vulnerable members of our society. The remaining 168kg (11%) of waste was landfilled via municipal waste collection. This is an amazing achievement that resembles last year's great work.
